House tour at Redcliffe Plantation State Historic Site

Grounds open daily 9am to 6pm year-round. Visitors Center open 11am to noon daily. House tours Th-Mon at 11am, 1pm and 3pm. Admission is charged for house tours. 181 Redcliffe Rd, Beech Island. 803-827-1473.

Catch a game or special event at SRP Park

Home of the Augusta GreenJackets, a minor league baseball team. Games scheduled April-September. Concerts and other special events held throughout the year. 187 Railroad Ave, North Augusta. 803-349-9467.

Relive Colonial Times at the Living History Park

Open daily dawn to dusk. Check the calendar before you plan your visit, as the park hosts Under the Crown in April, A Day to Remember in October and Christmas in the Backcountry in December. 299 W Spring Grove Ave, North Augusta. 803-279-7560.

Tour the Civil War Battlefield at Rivers Bridge State Historic Site

Open 9am to 6pm. Admission for Saturday tours is charged. Community building rental available. Accommodates up to 100. 325 State Park Rd. Off of SC 641, 7 miles SW of Ehrhardt. 803-267-3675.

Check the time at Barnwell's Vertical Sundial on the Circle

The unique vertical sundial is located in front of the courthouse. Legend has it that this is the only vertical sundial in the United States and though erected two years prior to standard time, it keeps within two minutes of that. 141 Main St, Barnwell.

Learn about SC Face Jugs at the Little Red Barn Gallery

Paddle the South Fork Edisto River Trail at Aiken State Park
